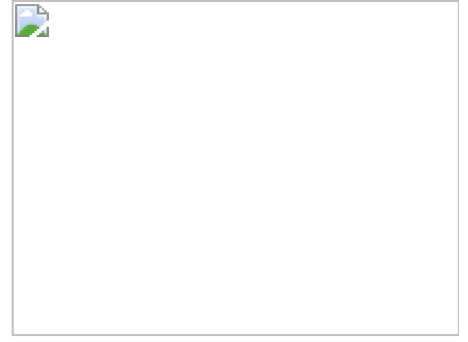
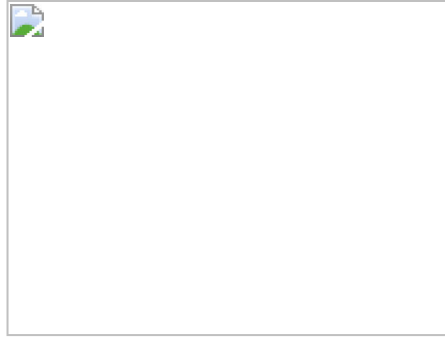
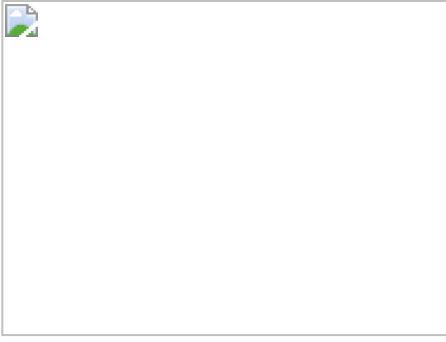
"The Body Through The Porthole" – Talk at our October Monthly Meeting (Fri 17th Oct, 2025)

It was a very varied holiday, the weather was good and there was so much to see and do and it was great to be amongst u3a friends.

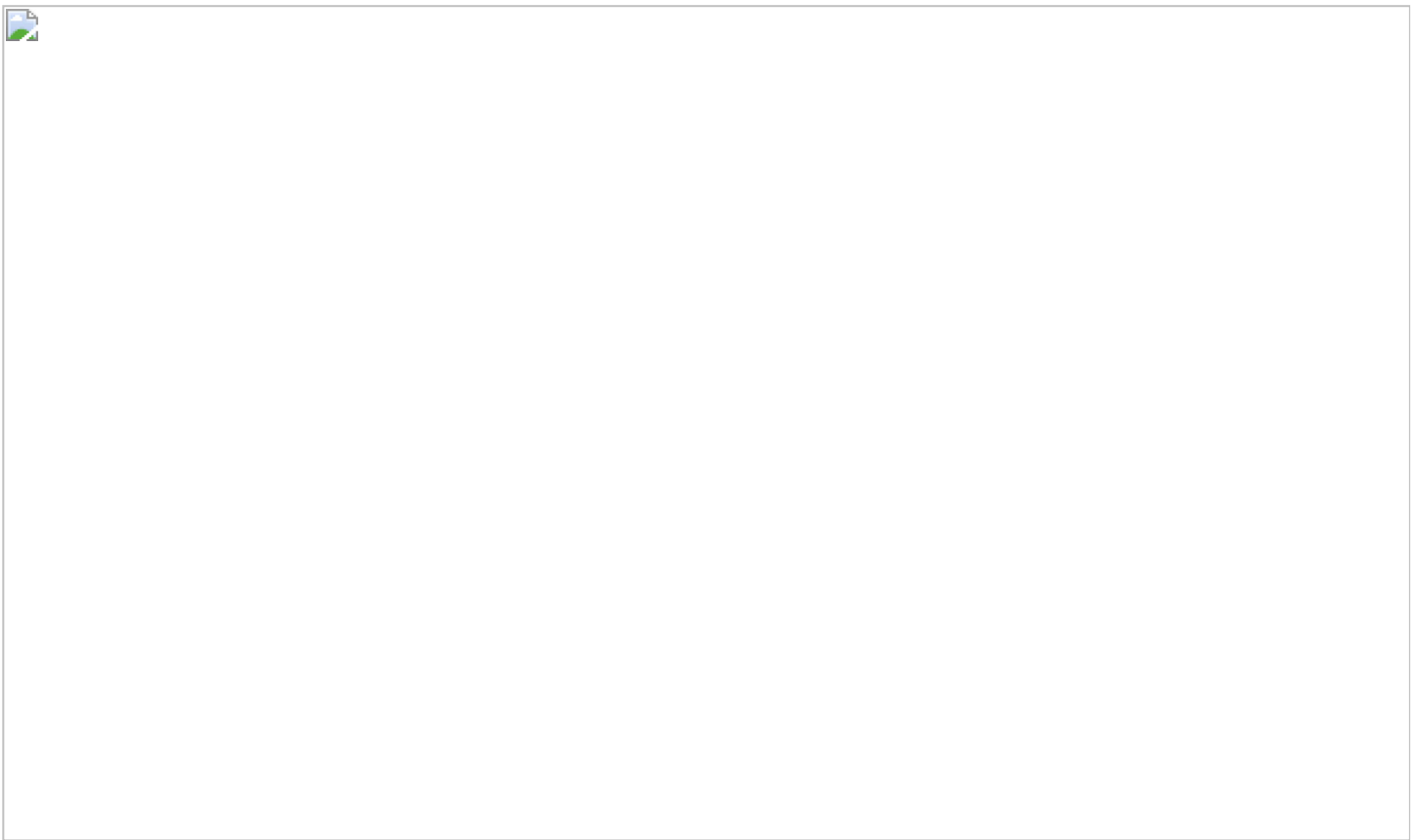
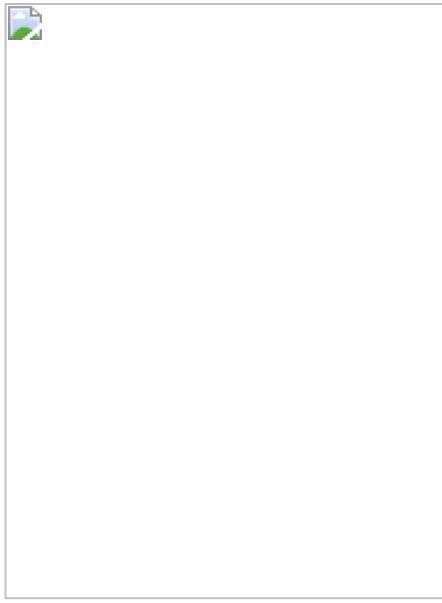
